A Heavy Machine Operator manages and operates heavy equipment like bulldozers and cranes on construction sites, ensuring safe, timely, and efficient project completion.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- ✓ Operate heavy equipment such as bulldozers, excavators, and cranes to move materials and complete construction projects
- ✓ Maintain and repair equipment as needed
- ✓ Follow safety procedures and ensure that work is performed safely and efficiently
- ✓ Collaborate with project managers, engineers, and other stakeholders to determine project requirements
- ✓ Perform routine maintenance and inspections on equipment
- ✓ Follow blueprints and plans to complete projects accurately and on time

PAY & SALARY (CALIFORNIA)

REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ High school diploma or equivalent
- ✓ Completion of a vocational or technical training program in heavy equipment operation
- ✓ Ability to read and interpret construction plans and blueprints
- ✓ Strong mechanical aptitude and problem-solving skills
- ✓ Knowledge of safety procedures and regulations for heavy equipment operation
